Creation – Family Discussion Guide

How to make God a part of your family every day of the week:

Take some time either around the dinner table or as a devotional time before bed and talk about the things you learned on Sunday. Help your students throughout the week to encounter the truth about God and sort out their beliefs. This will help them to grow in their faith. The following questions are things to consider about Sunday's Doctrine Topic and can serve a guide throughout the week.

Questions about Creation to think about:

Why is it important to understand creation?

How is the Biblical account different from other worldviews?

What are the implications that God created Ex Nihilo (out of nothing)?

From the creation account, is God orderly or chaotic?

Since God created everything in an orderly way with a purpose;

How does that affect how you see your own life?

What are the implications of Jesus' ministry on earth in light of this?

Does this affect how you live your life? In what ways?

Since God created everything perfect, does that affect your view of the sinful world we live in?

Since God created a world without sin, is it fair to blame God for the evil in the world?

Read Isaiah 46:10

What does this tell us about the things that happen in our lives?

What does this teach us about God's power? His Character? His Love?

Read Genesis 1:28

What did God command people to do?

What does this have to say about the work ethic?
