

Doctrine: Scripture ~ Family Discussion Guide

How to make God a part of your family every day of the week:

Take some time either around the dinner table or as a devotional time before bed and talk about the things you learned on Sunday. Help your students throughout the week to encounter the truth about God and sort out their beliefs. This will help them to grow in their faith. The following questions are things to consider about Sunday's Doctrine Topic and can serve a guide throughout the week.

Prophecy?

Self verification and consistency?

What does it mean that the Word of God is sufficient?

What part did God play in the production of the Bible?

What part did the human authors play in writing the Bible?

What is the difference between interpretation and application?

What characteristics of God give us confidence in the cannon of Scripture?

How has God revealed Himself to you through Scripture in the past week?

How does faith in the Word of God effect how you live your life today?

In what areas of your life have you resisted the Bibles Authority?

Give an example of where you see the Word of God living and active today.
